Dear Youth for Truth Parents.....Welcome to Youth for Truth! St. Peter's Catholic Church is blessing you with a Catholic Christian social circle for your 6th, 7th, and 8th graders. I am soooo excited about this year....we're going to have a blast! Just like with any extra-curricular activity, Youth for Truth has forms and rules also. So, let's get some housekeeping done and then get onto having fun!!

2. **REGISTRATION FORM** - Please complete and return the Registration Form for your Youth for Truth. You can mail or drop it off to the St. Peter's Parish Office, in the collection basket at mass, or to my house at 100 Bonnet Street, New Iberia, 70563. This form tells me more about your child and provides me with important contact information.
3. **LIABILITY FORM** - Please complete and return the Liability Form for your child. You can mail or drop it off to the St. Peter's Parish Office, in the collection basket at mass, or to my house at 100 Bonnet Street, New Iberia, 70563. St. Peter's insurance policies require that a Liability Form be on file for your child. This is especially necessary since transportation is involved for some of our events (see #5 - Transportation below).
4. **DROP-OFF/PICK-UP** - **Always WALK your child into and from any event.** Please do not let them come in alone or expect me to let them leave alone to meet you in a parking lot. I won't do it - it's not safe. Our events will be at various places - Loffland Hall, Parish Hall, Church, Bayou Pins, Consolata, etc - so this rule is very important and must be followed.
5. **TRANSPORTATION** - **Always communicate and coordinate your transportation need directly with me - not through your child.** Some of our events will require transportation. You are always welcome to stay at any Youth for Truth event and transport your own child; however, I know that many parents welcome the drop-off/pick-up option also.....and that is fine.....but you must make sure that you communicate and coordinate that with me directly - not through your child. **Also, a signed Liability Form must be on file before your child is transported.** Of course, proper communication is also needed for logistics' planning, i.e. enough drivers.
6. **BEHAVIOR** - **Please discuss appropriate Christian behavior with your child.** I will expect all Youth for Truth to be kind, loving, and respectful to each other and to all adults. This should not be new information and should be the same way they are expected to behave at home, in church, or at school. They will be expected to use manners and to clean up after themselves. No running is allowed in any building (except if part of a game). No horseplay. No name-calling or rude words (such as "shut-up" "sucks" "stupid" "hate") and absolutely no profanity. No taking the Lord's name in vain (such as "Oh my God" "God doggit").....as kids get older these can easily transform into their much uglier variations that we've all heard and I'd like them to learn early that this is not good Christian talk. I will gently remind them, but your support will be nice!
7. **RSVP** - **Please review each Upcoming Youth for Truth Events sent to you and RSVP by the deadlines given.** This is so I can make sure that there are enough adults to help, enough refreshments & supplies, etc. If you haven't RSVP'd by the deadline, I will assume your child is not attending that event....so please let me know. We'd love all Youth for Truth at all events....but if you can't make some, don't worry....there will be plenty of get togethers!!!!
